**NOTE:** The district will enroll the students at the receiving school. After the application is approved and parents are notified, parents have 14 calendar days from June 14, 2010 to cancel their application. If the application is not cancelled by June 28, 2010, the student will be enrolled and assigned to the receiving school and must remain at the receiving school the entire 2010-2011 school year. Should St. Martinville Jr. High make annual yearly progress for the 2009-2010 school year, school choice will be discontinued. Students currently enrolled at the receiving schools (Catahoula Elementary and Parks Middle School) during the 2009-2010 school year will be allowed to remain, however parents will have to provide transportation to and from the school.

*Every effort will be made to assign your child to the school that is your first choice. In the event that this is not possible, your child will be assigned to another choice as indicated on the School Choice Request Form. It should also be noted that federal law requires that student assignments be based on family income and student test scores. Students with the lowest income and test scores will receive priority in assignments.*
