To provide a preferred therapy option for the treatment of infertility.
Duac (clindamycin/ benzoyl peroxide)	Major Category Topical Subcategory Dermatology, Acne	Duac is indicated for the topical treatment of inflammatory acne vulgaris.	Duac (clindamycin/benzoyl peroxide) will replace Duac CS (clindamycin/ benzoyl peroxide/skin cleanser) on the Performance Drug List. Duac CS has been discontinued by the manufacturer.

In men for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Induction of spermatogenesis in men with primary and secondary hypogonadotropic hypogonadism (HH) in whom the cause of infertility is not due to primary testicular failure. Synvisc (hylan G-F 20)	Major Category Analgesics Subcategory Viscosupplements	Synvisc is indicated for the treatment of pain in osteoarthritis (OA) of the knee in patients who have failed to respond adequately to conservative non-pharmacologic therapy and simple analgesics (e.g., acetaminophen). Generic fexofenadine is available over-the-counter. The Antihistamines, Nonsedating category will be deleted from the Performance Drug List.
trandolapril-verapamil ext-rel	Major Category Cardiovascular Subcategory ACE Inhibitor/Calcium Channel Blocker Combinations	Trandolapril/verapamil extended-release is indicated for the treatment of hypertension.	Generic trandolapril/verapamil extended-release is no longer available from the manufacturer. The ACE Inhibitor/Calcium Channel Blocker Combinations category will be deleted from the Performance Drug List.
