## NOTES:

- 1. All full-time coaches must be involved in coaching 3 sports, or 2 sports and 1 off season sport to receive the percentage based stipend pay.
- 2. Coaches must have a CDL to qualify for this percentage based stipend pay; otherwise they are paid according to the previous schedule
- 3. Coaches not considered to be "full-time" (see number 1) will be paid at a rate of \$600 per sport coached.
- 4. All coaches who report a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the start of school will receive an additional \$400 per week. This amount will be pro-rated for coaches who work less than the 2 week period.
- 5. Coaches who participate in Summer Athletic Conditioning Program can earn up to four hours per day, three days per week for a total of 12 hours per week for a period of six weeks. Total amount to be earned if the entire program is worked is \$1,440. High schools can have up to 11 coaches and junior high schools can have up to two.
- 6. High school coaches can earn a maxium of 20%
- 7. Coaches that make the playoffs will be compensated for the extended season as follows: Football will receive an additional 10% of the coaching supplement for each week the team is involved in playoff games; All other sports will receive 5% of the coaching supplement for that sport for each week they are in the playoffs.
- 8. If coaches receive stipend pay for a sport they elect not to coach before the season begins their wages will be deducted for the amount received.
- 9. If a coach elects to give up their coaching position they may be required to transfer to another school if there are no open positions available at their current school.
- 10. If the AD position is occupied by an Administrator they will receive the percentage based stipend pay; otherwise the pay is \$1,000.
