On the motion of Mr. Blanchard, seconded by Mr. Ledoux, and unanimously carried, the Committee recommended approval of the agenda.

On the motion of Mr. Blanchard, seconded by Mr. Fuselier, and unanimously carried, the Committee recommended the following changes in disbursing Sales Tax Fund proceeds:

- a) Operational transfers from sales tax (Fund 70) for year ending June 30, 2009
- b) Rolling the current sales tax supplements of \$6,500 (professionals) and \$5,080 (paraprofessionals) into the current applicable salary schedule, and requiring that all future supplements be funded by sales tax proceeds and paid through the General Fund (no more impact to grants).
- c) Two new sales tax supplements of \$1,000 and \$715 for year ending June 30, 2009, to be paid through the General Fund.

On the motion of Mr. Blanchard, seconded by Mr. Fuselier, and unanimously carried, the Committee recommended public input and participation in the budgetary process and adoption of the Annual Operating Budget for fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.

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On the motion of Mr. Blanchard, seconded by Mr. Ledoux, and unanimously carried, the Committee recommended a refrigerated "Fast Track" Van to transport food products.

On the motion of Mr. Ledoux, seconded by Mrs. Latiolais, and unanimously carried, the Committee recommended lamps and lenses on the stadium lights at Breaux Bridge High, Cecilia High, and St. Martinville Senior High School.

On the motion of Mr. Knott, seconded by Mr. Ledoux, and unanimously carried, the Committee recommended to table the item relative to the extension to the existing weight room at Breaux Bridge High School and allow staff to conduct a study of each schools needs.

The Committee discussed the cost of hiring additional aides. No action was taken.
